

DISCIPLINARY CODE: DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR POLICY AND CONSEQUENCES

Discipline and its effectiveness vary with every child. Below is a general set of guidelines all staff will be expected to follow when dealing with misbehaving campers. The first week of a child's attendance in the camp is probationary. When it is found that a camper is experiencing difficulty due to a special need or behavior, the camp staff will work with the child and his/her parents to retain the child in the camp. Most attention will be paid to pro-active methods, such as proximity, to prevent any disruptive behavior problems. However, if the problem cannot be solved by pro-active measures, the following consequences will apply:

- 1. The group counselor will separate the camper from the group and verbally correct the camper.
- 2. Abusive or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated; campers will be separated from their group and have quiet time with a camp supervisor.
- 3. Should the safety of the staff or other campers be jeopardized, immediate termination from the camp will result.
